Customizing the Templates

You can make the following customisations to the templates:

Text: Update the template text to include specific details about your local Girls in Digital events, dates, or calls to action. Ensure your text remains clear and concise for your audience.

Photos: Replace the placeholder images with your own event or local photos that align with Girls in Digital themes. Ensure the images are high quality to maintain a professional look.

Logos: You can add your organisation's logo alongside the EU Code Week logo if necessary. However, do not modify the EU Code Week branding or its core elements, such as colours or logo placement.

Language: Translate the text into your local language to make it more relatable for your audience. Ensure that the message stays consistent with EU Code Week's overall tone.

TEditing with Canva

What is Canva? Canva is an online graphic design tool that allows you to edit templates easily. You will need a free Canva account to access and modify the designs. It's user-friendly and requires no design experience.

Copying the Design: Before making any edits, **make a copy of the template** by clicking "File" > "Make a Copy" within Canva. This ensures you won't overwrite the original template and allows you to safely customize your own version.

Exporting your custom design

Once you've made your changes, export the designs in the appropriate format for the platform:

For Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn, and Twitter posts: Export in PNG or JPEG formats.

For Instagram Stories: Ensure you use the 1080x1920px template size and export it as a PNG or JPEG as well.





Scheduling and Posting

Use the right-sized template for each social media platform. The sizes are optimized for best display on each platform

Share your posts with local partners and encourage them to reshare to expand the reach.
